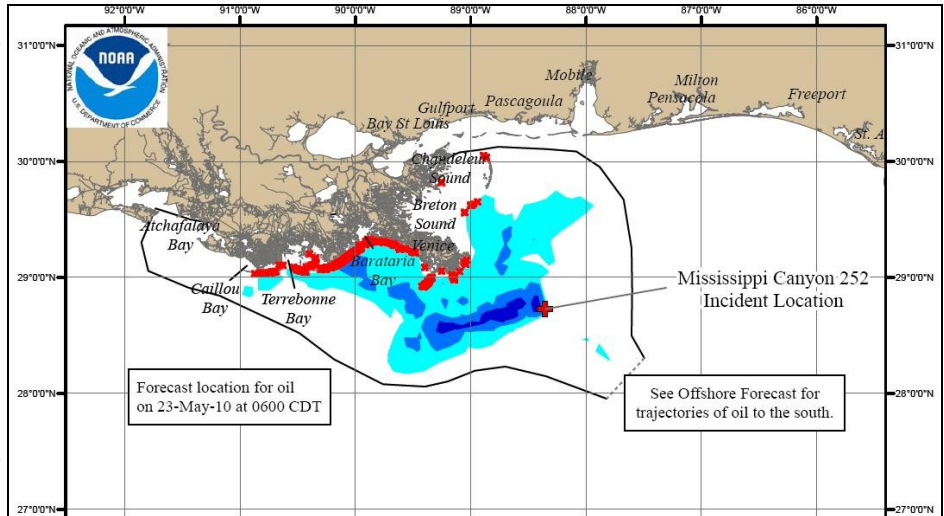
## GREENFIELD RESPONDS TO THE GULF OIL SPILL

All of us at Greenfield are sincerely concerned with the environmental tragedy in the Gulf of Mexico. We hope that a solution can be found soon to bring this oil spill to an end, so that a proper environmental remediation can begin.

With that in mind, we know that there are some very real economic issues confronting the citizens in the region. Based on our 34 years of experience in these situations, including our work on the Exxon Valdez Oil Spill and other environmental damage matters, we can already see four areas which merit immediate investigation:

- Property valuation losses along the Gulf of Mexico
- Business interruption losses, both currently and ongoing
- Use-and-enjoyment losses, both to citizens as well as to businesses which depend on proximity to Gulf coast beaches
- Losses to local taxing authorities (cities, counties, etc.)

Greenfield has established a task force to accumulate information and provide support to our clients. We are preparing a white paper on the property valuation and economic issues



relevant to this spill, with a focus on efficient and court-accepted methodologies to find answers to these problems.

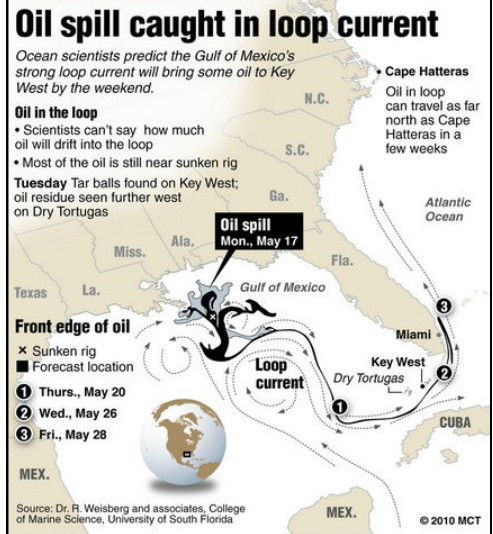
